



ADMISSION NOTICE FOR STUDENTS OF SCHOOL OF MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES, SEMESTER 2, ACADEMIC SESSION 2021/2022

- 1.0 This notice is in reference to the notice from Deputy Vice Chancellor (Academic & International) No. 3/2022 regarding the Guidelines for Preparation of Teaching and Learning and SOP of Student Admission Semester 2 Academic Session 2021/2022.
- 2.0 Please be informed that teaching and learning will be conducted online for all students. However, the following groups of students must be physically present on campus:
 - (a) All Year 1 Students
 - (b) All Year 4 Students
 - (c) Students who have enrolled in the following courses:
 - MAT111/4 Linear Algebra
 - MAT202/4 Introduction to Analysis
 - MSG382/3 Modelling Laboratory II
 - MSS416/4 Rings and Fields
- 3.0 For courses stated in point 2.0 (c) above, teaching and learning (lectures) will be held online, while tutorials will be held face-to-face. The complete teaching plan will be given by the lecturers in charge of the courses.
- 4.0 Students who need to attend classes face-to-face can apply for accommodation at the University. Students need to fill in Form A on CampusOnline (<http://campusonline.usm.my/>) which will be approved by the Dean of School of Mathematical Sciences.
- 5.0 Kindly note that only fully vaccinated international students (new and existing) are allowed to enter Malaysia. Students are required to undergo quarantine
 - for seven (7) days (without booster shot)
 - for five (5) days (with booster shot)at home or hotel under the supervision of the National Disaster Management Agency (NADMA).
- 6.0 Students are encouraged to contact their Academic Advisor should they have any issues and require advice regarding online learning.
- 7.0 The School of Mathematical Sciences is committed in preventing the transmission of Covid-19 and ensuring the well-being and welfare of students is at a satisfactory level. Students are advised to be alert with the announcements by the University and the School from time to time.
